Peanut Butter and Jelly (PBJ) Ministry



Donations for the food pantry are collected the first Sunday of every month? We collect the food and volunteers take it to Aldersgate UMC.


We will be hosting Homecoming on November 17th so tell your friends and family to come and re-connect. There might be someone here you haven't seen for a while.
